





Project Goals


- Promote civic pride

- Bring additional public art to Hudson


Potential Locations First and Main Green

Leadership Hudson collaborated with Door 2 Art Studio to provide the following enhancement to the base design:

From Door 2 Art Studio: "We are very excited about the Hudson sign project. Door 2 Art can uniquely enhance the already wonderful existing design by adding important historic and relevant Hudson symbols, logos and images.

We are including a basic mockup to illustrate the idea. Please keep in mind that the deigns would wrap around the sides and back adding interest from all vantage points. The possibilities for imagery, color, and design are endless. We can keep the designs Hudson blue, use multi colors, include a beautiful spray of flowers to represent our parks and Home and Garden tour. D2 can also create a community component to this project if desired.

Project Details

- Design
 - Interactive sit, climb, play, pose
 - Uplighting changing colors to signify events (holidays, awareness days, high school graduations)
 - Representative of Hudson classic design. The group is also coordinating with Door 2 Art Studio for opportunities to make this unique to Hudson.
 - Recognize supporters businesses, nonprofits, individual families etched onto side if sign
 - Respects the downtown greens
 - Durable, low-maintenance Signs are typically fabricated from steel or aluminum. Larger sign fabrication companies offer substantial maintenance guarantees. We spoke to the communities of Lorain, Bay Village, and Parma, all expressed low maintenance costs.
- Fully funded and installed by Leadership Hudson, then gifted to the City. Estimated projected cost = \$25,000
