A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR COMPETITIVE BIDS, AWARD AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE EAST CASE WATERLINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the existing transmission main and water service connections within the right-of-way on E. Case Road from State Route 303 approximately 830 feet South to Milford Road needs replacement; and,

WHEREAS, this section of transmission main has had seven breaks since 2011, and has exceeded its useful life for cast iron pipe and is considered the top maintenance issue for water distribution for the City Public Works Department; and,

WHEREAS, the project will replace the existing, 60 plus-year-old, 6" diameter cast iron transmission main with a new 8" diameter transmission line; and,

WHEREAS, in addition to reducing maintenance and interruptions to the residents, the new transmission main will improve fire flows in this area which feeds W. Case Drive and W. Streetsboro Road; and,

WHEREAS, construction of the project is currently scheduled for the winter of 2024 and is anticipated to be completed in the Spring of 2024; the asphalt resurfacing of E. Case Drive, W. Case Drive and Lynn Drive are also scheduled for the fall of 2024, after completion of the waterline work; and,

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the East Case Street Waterline Replacement is \$450,000, which includes a 10% contingency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to advertise both for a period of at least once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality and for a period of three (3) consecutive weeks on the Municipal website, requesting the submission of bids for the award and enter into a contract for the East Case Water Line Replacement Project in accordance with the specifications as supplied by the City Engineer's Office.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to sign all necessary documents and enter a contract or contracts on behalf of the City for the East Case Road Waterline Replacement Project in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00), with the lowest and best bidder after receipt of such bids which includes a ten percent (10%) contingency in excess of the Engineer's estimate.

- Section 3. The City Manager is further authorized to return all certified checks and bid bonds submitted by the unsuccessful bidders and to reject all bids for said contract or contracts if deemed necessary to do so.
 - That the above recitals are fully incorporated herein. Section 4.
- Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
