MAINTAIN AND PROTECT ASSETS

- Update and enhance current parks with new equipment and features (New Ellsworth clubhouse, replace aging playground equipment, etc.)
- 2. Develop and implement biological conservation plans including invasive species removal (Hudson Springs, Darrow Road)
- 3. Continue to replace and maintain aging vehicles and equipment.
- 4. Take yearly tours of all parks developed and undeveloped.
- Implement ongoing budget/financial review process (Budget Committee)
- 6. Continue to consider future maintenance and staffing costs/requirements for all potential projects.











RESPOND TO CHANGING COMMUNITY NEEDS

- 1. Continually collect, analyze and prioritize community feedback
- 2. Summarize and share community feedback with City Council on annual basis
- 3. Review recommendations of the new Comprehensive Plan relating to parkland.
- 4. Continue to monitor and refine (as needed) usage rules and regulations for all facilities.
- Consider developing a short electronic survey for continuous resident feedback.









PARKS AND RECREATION OPPORTUNITIES FOR ALL

- 1. Review and prioritize yet to be completed accessibility recommendations of the Park Master Plan.
- 2. Assist resident group planning and fund raising to build an inclusive playground in the northwest part of Hudson.
- 3. Consider ADA-accessible equipment when replacements are needed for picnic tables, playgrounds, etc.
- 4. Improve surfaces in all playgrounds.









PARTNERSHIPS FOR COMMUNITY BENEFIT

- 1. Assist resident groups raising funds for specific parks projects (Inclusive Playground, Pickleball/Tennis Lighting)
- 2. Continue to partner with, support and assist Friends of Hudson Parks.
- 3. Continue to meet with and support baseball, soccer and other leagues/organizations using Hudson ball fields.
- 4. Continue to explore potential land swap partnerships with Summit County Metro Parks







COMMUNICATIONS, INFORMATION SHARING, AND ORIENTATION

- 1. Develop and implement a plan to better communicate and educate Hudson residents regarding our parks system:
 - Website redesign (updated photos, description and maps)
 - Updated signage at individual parks communicating features, maintenance and education (QR codes)
 - Social media and weekly newsletter updates
- 2. Continue to participate in Hudson Earth Day with Friends of the Hudson Parks.
- Develop creative community outreach programs to encourage park usage.
