

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE SEWER CLEANING COMBO TRUCK FOR PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT OPERATIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Public Works Department is seeking to replace a jet/vacuum truck in order to provide critical services to the residents of Hudson; and

WHEREAS, multiple significant issues have arisen with the City's current equipment and the more prudent, cost effective measure is replacement; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid jet/vacuum truck and the cost proposal were selected and quoted by M-Tech Co. through Sourcewell (government contract #10122-SPL), an authorized State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program, which entity employs competitive bidding processes for equipment, satisfying the requirements for competitive bidding under the Ohio Revised Code and City law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1. That it is in the best interests of the City of Hudson and its operations to purchase the above-referenced equipment, i.e. the Sewer Cleaning Combo Truck (Vac Truck).

Section 2. That the City Manager and/or the City Manager's designee are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a purchase agreement with M-Tech Co. for the above-referenced equipment in an amount not to exceed \$560,000.

Section 3. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in a duly noticed open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience, and welfare of the City of Hudson and the inhabitants thereof, to secure the purchase price and to take delivery of this important health and safety equipment, and to allow for the continued, safe and reliable operations of the City's Public Works Department and shall, therefore, be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives an affirmative vote of at least six (6) members of the Council for its enactment if seven (7) are present, or an affirmative vote of at least five (5) members if only five (5) or six (6) members are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
