A RESOLUTION TO CONSENT TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S ("ODOT") RESURFACING OF STOW ROAD UNDER THE I-480 BRIDGES WITHIN THE CITY OF HUDSON (PID 111186).

WHEREAS, The Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") requires local consent legislation allowing it to perform work within Hudson City corporation limits; and

WHEREAS, ODOT will be replacing the bridge deck on I-480 over Stow Road; and

WHEREAS, due to this work and likely damage to the road surface on Stow Road in this area, ODOT will be resurfacing Stow Road underneath the I-480 bridges within the City oof Hudson, being assigned PID 111186 (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, ODOT will assume and bear 100% of all the costs of this project's improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: That, being in the public interest, the City hereby gives consent to the Ohio Department of Transportation to complete the Project.

<u>Section 2</u>: That the City Manager and City administration are hereby directed to cooperate with the Ohio Department of Transportation in the Project as follows:

- (a) The State shall assume and bear 100% of all the costs of the Project and the improvement;
- (b) The City agrees to pay one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of those features requested by the City which are determined by the State of Ohio and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the Project.

Section 3: The City agrees that all right-of-ways required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current state and federal regulations. Further, The City understands and acknowledges that right-of way costs include eligible utility costs.

- Section 4: Upon completion of the described Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the City shall:
 - (a) provide adequate maintenance for the described Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, 23 USC 116;
 - (b) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the Project;
 - (c) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and
 - (d) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.
- <u>Section 5</u>: The City Manager and his designee is hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the City of Hudson to sign any necessary documents and to enter into any necessary contracts with the Ohio Director of Transportation, which are necessary to complete the Project.
- Section 6: That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.
- Section 7: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in a duly noticed open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 8: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
