A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE ALISA COURT DRAINAGE DITCH PROJECT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER.

WHEREAS, residents on Alisa Court, near Nicholson Drive, have recently notified the City that during heavier rains, flows along the drainage ditch adjacent to their properties are causing erosion; and

WHEREAS, stormwater runoff from Ellsworth Meadows Golf Course and areas further upstream, combine and flow under Nicholson Drive, through a 30 inch pipe that discharges into a ditch between 5808 and 5790 Nicholson Drive; and

WHEREAS, during heavier rain events, high velocity flows are causing erosion to private property just downstream of the pipe's discharge point, and the sediment is then washed downstream; and

WHEREAS, the Alisa Court Drainage Ditch Project corrects these issues and involves adding channel protection along a sharp bend in the ditch, removing obstructions, and minor regrading to reduce ditch flooding and sediment transport; and

WHEREAS, the 2022 Policy for Work on Private property has been reviewed and was found to apply to this project based on the following:

- 1A. Public Nuisance and Public Benefit
- 1B. Reduces Flood Risk
- 1C. The drainage area is greater than 5 acres.
- 3. Exceeds Residents Capacity to Resolve.
- 4. Potential for infrastructure Damage when flooding occurs; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering Department will design the project in-house and the storm sewer work is planned for outside of the roadway; and

WHEREAS, the estimated project cost is \$250,000.00 including a 10% contingency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to advertise both for a period of at least once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality and for a period of three (3) consecutive weeks on the Municipal website, requesting the submission of construction bids for the purpose of seeking the lowest and best bidder for the Alisa Court Drainage Ditch Project in accordance with the specifications as supplied by the City Engineer's office.

Section 2. The City Manager and/or his designee is authorized to enter into a contract or contracts on behalf of the City in an amount up that which has been appropriated by Council, subject to the affixing to the contract by the Finance Director of a certificate of availability of funds therefor and the approval as to form by the City Solicitor, with the lowest and best bidder after receipt of such bids to the extent that such bid is not in excess of the Engineer's estimate at the time of bidding, including a ten percent (10%) contingency, which together currently totals \$250,000.

Section 3. The City Manager and/or his designee is further authorized to return all certified checks and bid bonds submitted by the unsuccessful bidders and to reject all bids for said contract if deemed necessary to do so.

- <u>Section 4</u>. The aforesaid project is in the City and its residents' best interest.
- Section 5. The above recitals are fully incorporated as findings herein.

Section 6. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 7. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
