

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 15-189 MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES OF THE CITY OF HUDSON DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2016 BY MAKING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

**Section 1** That the appropriations heretofore made for current expenses and other expenditures for the City of Hudson during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2016, the sums hereinafter indicated by fund are amended.

**Section 2** That the current appropriations be amended in the General Fund (101) as follows:

**Section 4** That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to make expenditures or payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certifications and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve same or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance.

**Section 5** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
