

RESOLUTION NO. 21-41

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH AECOM TECHNICAL SERVICES, INC. FOR THE STOW ROAD AND STATE ROUTE 303 SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson requested a formal statement of qualifications and proposals from experienced consultants for the Stow Road and SR 303 Sidewalk Improvement Project (hereinafter, the "Project") for the survey, analysis, and design of the Project; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends awarding a contract to the AECOM Technical Services, Inc. for professional services to survey, analyze and design a 5-foot sidewalk on Stow Road from Hudson Springs Park Driveway to State Route 303 and State Route 303 from Stow Road to Hayden Parkway, in an amount of One Hundred Ninety-Eight Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Nine Dollars (\$198,429.00), which includes a 10% contingency; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to award said contract to the AECOM Technical Services, Inc. of Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a professional services contract with the AECOM Technical Services, Inc. for professional consulting services for the Project, in an amount of One Hundred Ninety-Eight Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Nine Dollars (\$198,429.00).

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
