A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH VIZMEG LANDSCAPE, INC. FOR ADDITIONAL LANDSCAPING MAINTENANCE SERVICES FOR THE BASEBALL FIELDS AT BARLOW FARM PARK; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 17-149, this Council authorized a two-year contract with Vizmeg Landscape, Inc. to provide landscaping maintenance services for the City of Hudson; and

WHEREAS, City staff has determined that there is a need to perform landscaping maintenance repairs to the four (4) baseball fields located at Barlow Farm Park due to water issues at the Park that developed this year; and

WHEREAS, if left unrepaired, then the ballfields will constitute a safety issue for users of the ballfields at the Park; and,

WHEREAS, only the repairs which are necessary to be performed this year will be authorized pursuant to this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an amendment to an existing agreement with Vizmeg Landscape, Inc. for the provision of landscaping maintenance services for the Barlow Farm Park baseball fields for an additional amount not to exceed Fifty-Two Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$52,400.00).

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to perform the repairs that are the subject of this Resolution in order for the baseball fields at Barlow Farm Park to be safe to use in time for the upcoming 2020 baseball season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council elected thereto, or six (6) affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
