RESOLUTION NO. 22-66

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO BID AND AWARD CONTRACTS FOR THE EASTSIDE SUBSTATION TRANSFORMER REPLACEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Eastside Substation replacement project will require the purchase of substation electrical equipment and components and a project construction contract; and

WHEREAS, staff has requested authorization to bid and award contracts for three (3) substation transformer voltage regulators, steel structures; switches; bussing and required associated electrical components; and a contract for project construction

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized to advertise for a period of at least once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality and for a period of three (3) consecutive weeks on the Municipal website, requesting the submission of said bids for the Eastside Substation Transformer Replacement project in accordance with the specifications as supplied by the Public Works Office.

<u>Section 2</u>: The City Manager is authorized to enter into contracts on behalf of the City, subject to the affixing to the contracts by the Finance Director of a certificate of availability of funds therefor, with the lowest and best bidder after receipt of such bids to the extent that such bid is not ten percent (10%) in excess of the Engineer's Estimate.

<u>Section 3</u>: The City Manager is authorized to add a 10% contingency amount, based upon the construction cost, to the contract or contracts with the lowest and best bidder.

<u>Section 4</u>: The Finance Director is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account the funds necessary for the contract authorized in Section 2 of this Resolution.

<u>Section 5</u>: The City Manager is further authorized to return all certified checks and bid bonds submitted by the unsuccessful bidders and to reject all bids for said contract or contracts if deemed necessary to do so.

<u>Section 6</u>: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 7:</u> This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
