

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO
A CONTRACT FOR SNOW AND ICE CONTROL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City has competitively bid a contract for snow and ice control services on City properties for a term to begin November 1, 2020, and to run through May 31, 2022, with an option for a two-year renewal after the end of the initial term; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended by the City Manager's Office and the Public Works Department that H & M Snow Pros, Inc. be awarded the contract, as the sole bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with H & M Snow Pros, Inc. for the snow and ice removal services set forth in this Resolution for a term to begin November 1, 2020 and to run through May 31, 2022 in the annual amount not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Forty-Five Dollars (\$259,545.00), subject to appropriations by Council.

Section 2: The City Manager is further authorized to exercise an option to renew said contract for up to two (2) additional years dependent upon pricing and quality of service and subject to appropriations for this renewal contract by Council.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution will take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
