

RESOLUTION NO. 20-111

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO
A LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR A FENCE AT 374 NORTH MAIN STREET.

WHEREAS, this Council has determined it is not inconsistent with the public health, safety and general welfare for the City of Hudson to grant a nonexclusive, revocable license to Suzanne Morgan in the City's public right-of-way area in front of 374 N. Main Street for the purposes of installing a residential fence located on the front of the property; and

WHEREAS, the subject property and existing location of the home at 374 N. Main Street are unique and the fence that is being installed at the same setback and of compatible design of the adjacent properties along N. Main Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a non-exclusive license agreement with Suzanne Morgan for the placement of a fence at the location set forth in the preamble to this Resolution, and that is terminable by the City and in a form that is otherwise acceptable to the City Manager, City Solicitor, Community Development Director, and City Engineer.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
