A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE 5521.01 CONSENTING TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO COMPLETE THE SR 91 BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT (PID NO. 106136) WITHIN THE CITY OF HUDSON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF HUDSON TO SERVE AS THE LOCAL PUBLIC AGENCY, AND AUTHORIZING FUNDS THEREFOR.

Brief Description: The project is being sponsored and managed by the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT). ODOT is required to request and receive legislation from the City of Hudson prior to making any repairs to State Highways within the corporate limits of the municipality. This project will include the removal and replacement of the existing bridge under SR 91 just south of Ravenna Street. As part of the project, the City has requested widening of the sidewalk along the west side of SR 91 to better accommodate a future multi-purpose path along this section of roadway.

Legislative History

None.

Purpose & Explanation

ODOT is required to request and receive legislation from the City of Hudson prior to making any repairs to State Highways within the corporate limits of the municipality. This request is for the replacement of the 14-foot by 8-foot bridge under SR 91 near Yours Truly Restaurant, PNC Bank and the Evaporator Works within the corporation limits of the City of Hudson. As part of the project, the City has requested that the sidewalk along the west side of SR 91 be widened to eight (8) feet and elevated to better accommodate a future multi-purpose path along this section of roadway. See project plan attached.

The City of Hudson's estimated cost for widening of the sidewalk work is \$175,000. For a portion of the construction, when the existing bridge sections are removed and replaced, SR 91 will be closed for up to 16 consecutive calendar days. During this time, a detour will be posted. This is not a traditional LPA project and Hudson will not be overseeing the construction. The project plans have been completed by ODOT and construction is scheduled for the summer of 2023.

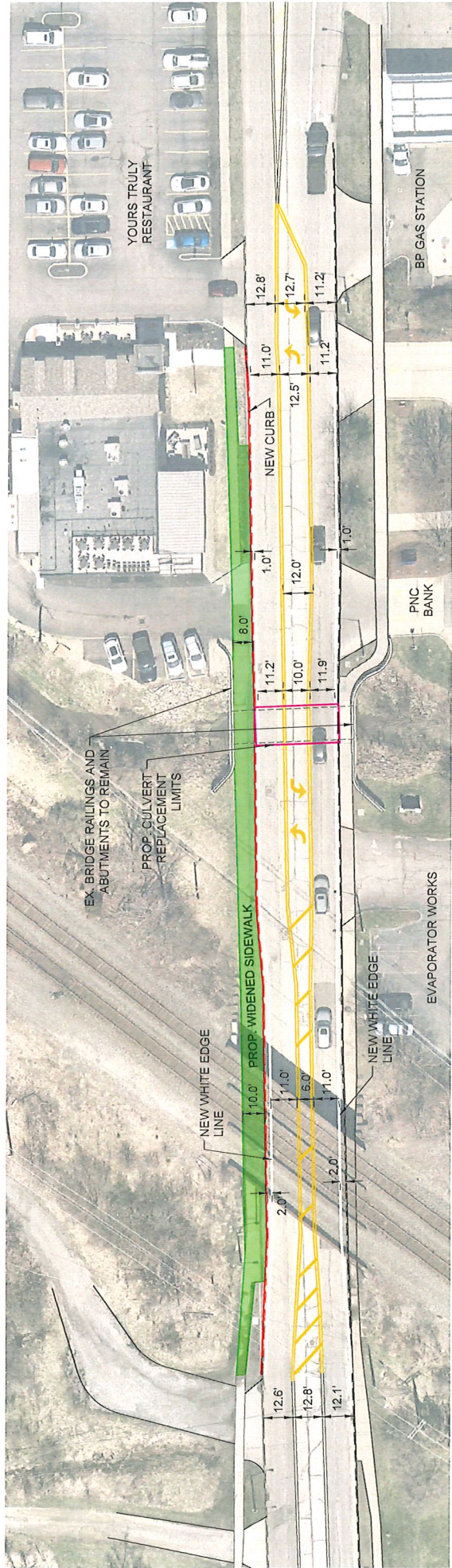
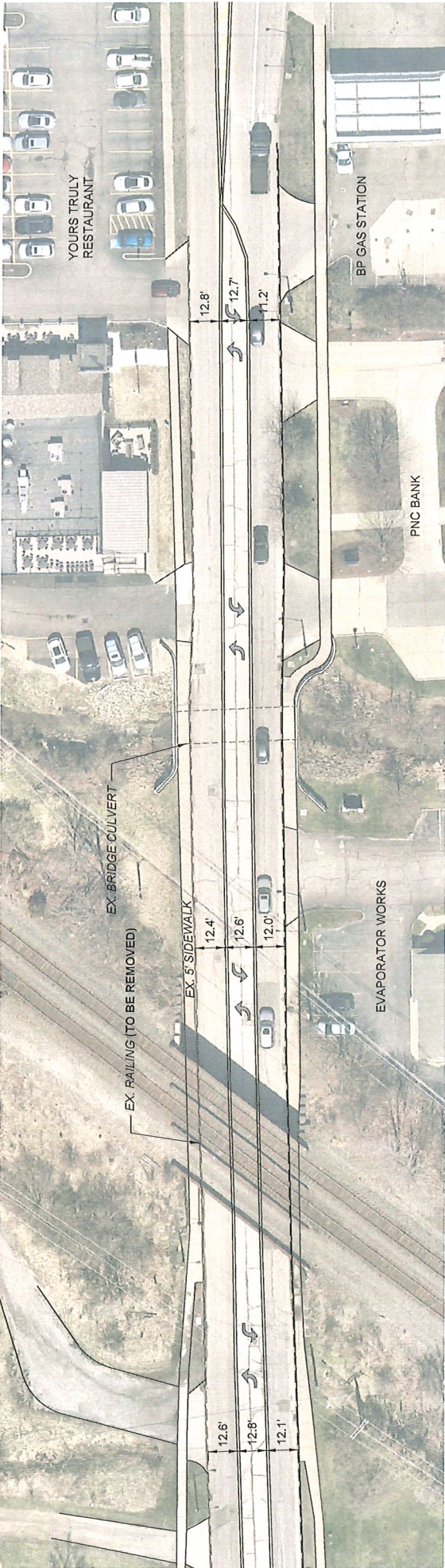
Suggested Action

SECTION I - Project Description

WHEREAS, the STATE has identified the need for the described project:

Construction of a multiuse trail along SR91 in the City of Hudson. Includes the removal of the barnstones around SFN 7707290, five culvert replacements and drainage work.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City of Hudson of Summit County, Ohio.

SECTION II - Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

SECTION III - Cooperation Statement

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The LPA agrees to participate in the cost of construction within the city limits at one hundred percent (100%) total cost.

The LPA further agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost of those features requested by the LPA which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the Project.

The LPA further agrees that change orders and extra work contracts required to fulfill the construction contracts shall be processed as needed. The State shall not approve a change order or extra work contract until it first gives notice, in writing, to the LPA. The LPA shall contribute its share of the cost of these items in accordance with other sections herein.

(Optional-if required) The LPA further agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost to install and/or repair curb ramps at all necessary intersections to ensure compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

SECTION IV - Maintenance

Upon completion of the described Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the LPA shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the described Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, 23 USC 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the described Project; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

SECTION V - Authority to Sign

The _____ of said _____ City of Hudson _____ is hereby empowered on
(Contractual Agent) (LPA)
behalf of the _____ City of Hudson _____ to enter into contracts with ODOT pre-qualified consultants
(LPA)
for the preliminary engineering phase of the Project and to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.

Upon the request of ODOT, the _____ is also empowered to assign all rights,
(Contractual Agent)
title, and interests of the _____ City of Hudson _____ to ODOT arising from any agreement with its
(LPA)
consultant in order to allow ODOT to direct additional or corrective work, recover damages due to errors or omissions, and to exercise all other contractual rights and remedies afforded by law or equity.

The LPA agrees that if Federal Funds are used to pay the cost of any consultant contract, the LPA shall comply with 23 CFR 172 in the selection of its consultant and the administration of the consultant contract. Further the LPA agrees to incorporate ODOT's "Specifications for Consulting Services" as a contract document in all of its consultant contracts. The LPA agrees to require, as a scope of services clause, that all plans prepared by the consultant must conform to ODOT's current design standards and that the consultant shall be responsible for ongoing consultant involvement during the construction phase of the Project. The LPA agrees to include a completion schedule acceptable to ODOT and to assist ODOT in rating the consultant's performance through ODOT's Consultant Evaluation System.
