

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE TO THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY FOR AN ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS COVID-19 SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT.

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency is awarding Assistance to Firefighters Covid-19 Supplemental Grant Program funding for the purpose of providing assistance to fire and emergency medical services for the purchase of Covid-related personal protective equipment and supplies; and;

WHEREAS, the City Staff is seeking Assistance to Firefighters Covid-19 Supplemental Grant funding to assist with the purchase of personal protective equipment to create a stockpile to ensure the ability to safely respond to Covid-19 related calls beyond the estimated current inventory. The Hudson Fire Department and Hudson Emergency Medical Services could receive Twelve Thousand Thirty-Four Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$12,034.60) in grant funding to assist with funding eligible Covid-related personal protective equipment and supplies – with a One Thousand Two Hundred Three Dollar and Forty-Six Cent (\$1,203.46) match required as part of participation in the grant program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Council hereby affirms the City Manager's designee's actions to execute and file an application with the Federal Emergency Management Agency for Assistance to Firefighters Covid-19 Supplemental Grant funding, having provided all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
