A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR COMPETITIVE BIDS FOR THE CAPITAL MAINTENANCE PROGRAMS OF THE CITY OF HUDSON; AND DECLARING AND EMERGENCY.

**Executive Summary:** This Resolution would authorize the advertisement for bids for the six annual road programs that comprise the Annual Capital Maintenance Program. The program includes: Line Striping, Crack Sealing, Concrete Replacement, Sidewalk Connectivity and Asphalt Resurfacing and Asphalt Road Reconstruction.

- A. <u>15-0003</u> Discussion: Discontinued Use of "Slow Children at Play" Signs and the Future Status of These Signs Currently Installed Throughout the City.

**Executive Summary:** The Ohio Department of Transportation has removed the "Slow Children at Play" signs from the current Ohio Manual of Unified Traffic Control Devices. The Public Works and Engineering Departments use the manual to manage the City's sign inventory and typically have adhered to the rules, regulations and signage instructions as published. Therefore, the Public Works Department no longer approves or installs these signs and seeks City Council support of a systematic removal plan for the existing signs in the field.
