HPP Materials Note: The price of the materials used in the manufacturing of wiring, transformers, poles and fiberglass, which also includes the materials needed for the above projects, is greatly affected by the volatility of market prices on petroleum and precious metals (copper and aluminum). Consequently, vendors will only hold their prices firm for 7 days, at the most. When items are needed, the HPP management compares prices from a number of vendors and orders materials from the lowest priced vendor prior, to entering into purchase arrangements. These items are purchased on an "as-

needed basis" for various scheduled replacement projects. Due to the nature of the space at our storage facilities, large amounts of inventory are not kept on site. Over a year's time, the amount sent to any given vendor may exceed \$25,000. Finance request we inform Council of this situation and receive permission to purchase.
