A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE ACCEPTANCE BY THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE OF AN EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT FROM THE OHIO OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES ON BEHALF OF THE HUDSON POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, this Council passed Resolution No. 18-153 on November 6, 2018, affirming submission of an application by the City Manager's designee for an Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant for Law Enforcement through the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services to fund the cost of tactical headsets to be used by Metro SWAT, of which the Hudson Police Department is a member; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services has awarded said grant to the City of Hudson on behalf of the Hudson Police Department in the amount of \$6,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Metro SWAT has agreed to provide required matching funds through Fare Share Fees in the amount of \$680.00 for said grant, so that there will be no cost to the City, and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to affirm the acceptance of said grant and supplemental funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

- <u>Section 1</u>. This Council affirms acceptance by the City Manager's designee of funding in an amount of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00) from the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services for the purpose set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.
- <u>Section 2</u>. This Council further affirms acceptance of funding in an amount of Six Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$680.00) from Metro SWAT to fund the required matching cost for subject grant.
- Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be	in full force and effect from and after the earliest
