Recognition of See Something, Say Something Week

WHEREAS, See Something, Say Something teaches students how they can make a difference in the safety of their school and the health of their friends and family by looking for warning signs, signals and threats from individuals who may want to hurt themselves or others and to talk with a trusted adult to get help; and

WHEREAS, See Something, Say Something benefits young people, educators, administrators, community-based organizations, parents and caretakers by building a culture of looking out for and caring for one another; and

WHEREAS, by reporting possible threats of violence when someone sees, reads or hears something, entire communities become safer and lives are saved; and

WHEREAS, thanks to the leadership of Hudson Community First and the participation of Hudson City Schools, Hudson Montessori School, Seton Elementary School, and the City of Hudson, See Something, Say Something Week will feature an awareness campaign, public announcements, special lessons for students, and training sessions for parents.
