A RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE LEGAL SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF HUDSON AND REAFFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF MARSHAL M. PITCHFORD AS CITY SOLICITOR; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended that City Council authorize an amendment to its prior agreement with DiCaudo, Pitchford & Yoder, LLC dated May 1, 2022; and,

WHEREAS, City Council desires to reaffirm the appointment of Marshal M. Pitchford as City Solicitor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, of Summit County, State of Ohio as follows:

- <u>Section 1:</u> The City Manager is hereby authorized retroactively to execute an amendment to the May 1, 2022 agreement with DiCaudo, Pitchford & Yoder to provide legal services to the City of Hudson, in accordance with the fees, scope of services and billing rate contained in the amendment, which is attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated into this Resolution as though fully rewritten herein. All the City Manager's actions to date on this topic are hereby ratified and affirmed.
- <u>Section 2:</u> Marshal M. Pitchford's appointment as Solicitor for the City of Hudson is reaffirmed effective as of November 1, 2022.
- Section 3: The Solicitor shall each be paid compensation as provided in the amendment attached hereto as Exhibit "A."
- Section 4: All prior resolutions and ordinances that relate to or in any way conflict with this measure are hereby repealed and rescinded.
- <u>Section 5:</u> All formal actions of this Council related to this Resolution and all deliberations of the Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 6: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience, and welfare of the City of Hudson and the inhabitants thereof, and for the further reason that this Resolution must be immediately effective in order to provide for the immediate legal services provided for herein, which are necessary to preserve and protect the legal interests of the City of Hudson. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
