

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF STOW FOR COOPERATION AND COST SHARING FOR THE NORTON ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the City of Stow for cooperation and cost sharing for the Norton Road Resurfacing project, a copy of which agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to commence and complete the within public improvement project at the earliest possible time in this construction season for the safety of the motoring public; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
