A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CONTRACT WITH TMS ENGINEERS INC. FOR THE CENTRAL ADAPTIVE TRAFFIC CONTROL SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson (City) requested a formal statement of proposals from experienced traffic consultants for the analysis, engineering and design of a fully integrated Central Adaptive Signal Control Technology (ASCT) Traffic Signal Improvement Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined to move forward with the above-described Project; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends awarding a professional services contract to TMS Engineers, Inc. for professional services for the Project, in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred One Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars (\$301,273.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a professional service contract with TMS Engineers Inc. for the Project in an amount of Three Hundred One Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars (\$301,273.00).

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
