

RESOLUTION NO. 15-86

OFFERED BY: MAYOR CURRIN

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OWNER OF 6052 OLDE EIGHT ROAD TO TAP INTO THE CITY OF HUDSON’S WATER SYSTEM IN THE VILLAGE OF BOSTON HEIGHTS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, an owner of property in the Village of Boston Heights, is in need of potable water for his residential property at 6052 Olde Eight Road (the “Subject Property”) and the only feasible source of such water is from the City of Hudson water line; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Boston Heights is amenable to the City of Hudson supplying water to the Subject Property through the existing Hudson water line located in the Village of Boston Heights.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with the owner of 6052 Olde Eight Road to permit the owner to tap into the Hudson water line in the Village of Boston Heights, which agreement shall be approved as to legal form by the City Solicitor.

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the public, and for the further reason that the extension of the water line is necessary at this time in order to provide potable water to an existing residential home where the water well has failed; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council, except that six (6) affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
