A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT A CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT FROM THE STATE OF OHIO PRESERVATION OFFICE AND TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 21-21, passed by this Council on March 2, 2021, submission of the City's application for a Certified Local Government Grant was affirmed; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Preservation Office has awarded a Certified Local Government Grant in the amount of \$20,000.00 to the City of Hudson to fund Consultant Services for the Historic District Expansion National Register Nomination.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized to accept a grant from the State of Ohio Preservation Office in the amount of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) for the purpose set forth in the recitals to this Resolution.

Section 2: The City Manager is further authorized to enter into a Grant Agreement therefor.

<u>Section 3.</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 4.</u> This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
