

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF A HUDSON
SIGN PUBLIC ART SCULPTURE AT VETERANS WAY PARK,
DONATED BY LEADERSHIP HUDSON CLASS OF 2024.**

WHEREAS, the Leadership Hudson Class of 2024 has commissioned and prepared designs for a “HUDSON” sign to be installed at Veterans Way Park; and

WHEREAS, Leadership Hudson has presented the City with a concept proposal for the project, which has been reviewed by the Hudson Park Board; and

WHEREAS, the sign will help celebrate community pride, help activate the park, and create “shareable photo opportunities;” and

WHEREAS, the Leadership Hudson Class of 2024 will be raising additional funds for this effort to help supplement a grant received by the Hudson Community Foundation; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds that the installation of the “HUDSON” sign at Veterans Way Park is in the best interest of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. The City hereby accepts the donation of the “HUDSON” sign from Leadership Hudson and/or the Hudson Community Foundation and authorizes its installation at Veterans Way Park, subject to the City Manager’s oversight and direction.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to do all things necessary to allow and support the installation of the “HUDSON” sign being donated by the Leadership Hudson Class of 2024. Further, the City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with Leadership Hudson for the installation of the sign at Veterans Way Park and may require any and all measures necessary to protect the City.

Section 3. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
