A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE CITY MANAGER'S ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT FROM THE BURTON D. MORGAN FOUNDATION ON BEHALF OF HUDSON COMMUNITY TELEVISION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 20-155, passed by this Council on December 1, 2020, submission of a grant application to the Burton D. Morgan Foundation by the City Manager's designee, on behalf of Hudson Community Television (HCTV), was supported and affirmed; and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded, and the City Manager recently accepted grant funding in the amount of \$1,200.00 to assist with the production costs of the *Good Day in Hudson* television series on HCTV.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. This Council affirms the City Manager's acceptance of a grant from the Burton D. Morgan Foundation in the amount of One Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00) for the purpose set forth in the recital to this Resolution.

<u>Section 2</u>.
