A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH O.C.I. CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR BROADBAND CONDUIT AND FIBER OPTIC CABLE INSTALLATION.

WHEREAS, competitive bids were received for underground installation and termination of broadband conduit and fiber optic cable in portions of the Historic Downtown, the Darrow Road corridor, Corporate Drive, Hudson Crossings, and Patriot Parkway; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has recommended that the bid of O.C.I. Construction, Inc., Novelty, Ohio, be accepted by this Council as being the lowest and best bid; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to accept the bid of O.C.I. Construction, Inc. as being the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The bid of O.C.I. Construction, Inc., Novelty, Ohio, for the underground installation of broadband conduit and fiber optic cable in portions of the Historic Downtown, the Darrow Road corridor, Corporate Drive, Hudson Crossings, and Patriot Parkway, being the lowest and best bid, is accepted and the City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with O.C.I. Construction, Inc. for the total amount of \$137,860, which includes a 10% contingency.

<u>Section 2.</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
