A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR COMPETITIVE BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE W. STREETSBORO STREET STORM IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

.

WHEREAS, the W. Streetsboro Street Storm Improvement Project will involve the enclosure of a deep ditch on the south side of W. Streetsboro Street between W. Case Drive and Westhaven Drive; and

WHEREAS, this project will follow the installation of the on-going transmission waterline replacement project along W. Streetsboro Road so that costs and City resources are saved; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of the storm sewer improvements, a new sidewalk is anticipated to be constructed along this alignment; and

WHEREAS, the project will eliminate a dangerous, deep ditch along the south side of this section of W. Streetsboro Street, improving the health and safety of the City and its residents because the current ditch slope is steep, such that a motorist, encroaching upon the ditch, may not be able to stop or slow down enough to return safely to the roadway; and,

WHEREAS, the project meets the following criteria established by the City's Private Property Storm Water Policy:

- 1A. The drainage issue is a public nuisance, and the improvement is a public benefit.
- 1B. The improvement reduces the risk of flooding properties adjacent to the improvement.
- 1C. The drainage area is between five (5) and 300 acres (approximately 22 acres).
- 3. Exceeds the resident's capacity to resolve; and,

WHEREAS, the project is being designed in-house by the City staff and the estimated project cost of construction, including a 10% contingency, is \$875,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to advertise both for a period of at least once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality and for a period of three (3) consecutive weeks on the Municipal website, requesting the submission of construction bids for the purpose of seeking the lowest and best bidder for the W. Streetsboro Street Storm Improvement Project, in accordance with the specifications as supplied by the City Engineer's office.

- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract or contracts on behalf of the City in an amount to be appropriated by Council, subject to the affixing to the contract by the Finance Director of a certificate of availability of funds therefor and the City Solicitor's approval, with the lowest and best bidder after receipt of such bids to the extent that such bid is not ten percent (10%) in excess of the Engineer's stated estimate at the time of bidding.
- Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to add a 10% contingency amount to the contract with lowest and best bidder, of which the total contract price, including any contingency amounts, shall not exceed Eight Hundred Seventy Five Thousand Dollars (\$875,000.00).
- Section 4. The City Manager is further authorized to return all certified checks and bid bonds submitted by the unsuccessful bidders and to reject all bids for said contract if deemed necessary to do so.
 - <u>Section 5</u>. That the above recitals are fully incorporated as findings herein.
- Section 6. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
