A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CONTRACT WITH PRIME AE GROUP FOR A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR THE TEREX ROAD AT HUDSON INDUSTRIAL PARKWAY AND EAST BARLOW ROAD INTERSECTIONS.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson (City) is interested in a feasibility study to survey, analyze, review, and provide long-term solutions to improve the safety at the Terex Road and Hudson-Industrial Parkway and East Barlow Road Intersections; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined to move forward with the above-described feasibility study for the Terex Road and Hudson-Industrial Parkway and East Barlow Road Intersections (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, staff recommends awarding a professional services contract to Prime AE Group for professional services for the feasibility study phase of the Project, in an amount of \$42,653.00, which amount includes a 10% contingency fee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a professional service contract with Prime AE Group for the feasibility study in an amount of \$38,775.00, plus a 10% contingency amount of \$3,878.00, for a total amount not to exceed Forty-Two Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-Three Dollars (\$42,653.00).

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
