A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GREAT LAKES RECYCLING, INC. DBA SIMPLE RECYCLING TO PROVIDE A RESIDENTIAL CURBSIDE RECYCLING PROGRAM FOR DISCARDED TEXTILES AND SMALL HOME APPLIANCES.

WHEREAS, the City's Environmental Awareness Committee has recommended the City offer a residential curbside recycling service for used textiles and small home appliances; and

WHEREAS, Great Lakes Recycling, Inc. DBA Simple Recycling agrees to pay the City of Hudson \$0.01 per pound of the total pounds collected on a monthly basis; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires that the City Manager enter into a contract with Great Lakes Recycling, Inc. DBA Simple Recycling for a term of three (3) years, allowing Simple Recycling to provide said recycling services to Hudson residents at no cost to the resident or the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. This Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to proceed with entering into a service contract with Great Lakes Recycling, Inc. DBA Simple Recycling for the provision of residential curbside recycling for used textiles and small home appliances for a three (3) year term.

Section 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
