

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR THREE POLICE VEHICLES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson has the authority to purchase vehicles through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained a price from Lebanon Ford, Lebanon, Ohio, under the State of Ohio Procurement State Term Schedule Contract No. RS901214 for three Ford Police Interceptor Utility vehicles for the Police Department in the amount of \$75,513 after receiving quotations from other vendors for the purpose of three police cruisers at the end of their useful life.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Hudson a purchase agreement with Lebanon Ford, Lebanon, Ohio for three 2016 Ford Police Interceptor Utility vehicles for a total not to exceed \$75,513, which purchase amount is approved in the 2015 City Budget.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to purchase the three vehicles to maintain police patrols in the City; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council elected thereto, or six (6) affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
