Special Recognition of Dr. James Boex

WHEREAS, Dr. Boex has been active in healthcare and health professions education for nearly fifty years; and

WHEREAS, Joining the Northeastern Ohio Universities College of Medicine (NEOUCOM, now NEOMED) in the 1970s, he held administrative assignments in both the Dean's office and the President's office, and helped to develop a wide range of the College's policies and practices; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Boex's nationally-recognized work on community-based health professions education and the interactions between clinical education and clinical care was supported by HRSA, the CDC, the Kellogg Foundation, the New York and Massachusetts Departments of Health, and others; and

WHEREAS, For approximately ten years Boex successfully represented NEOUCOM in Columbus and Washington, working with regulators and legislators on a variety of health care and health professions education initiatives; and

WHEREAS, After joining The University of Cincinnati in 2006, Dr. Boex served as founding Director of the university's MPH degree program and as founding Associate Director of its innovative on-line MHA degree program; and

WHEREAS, Following his retirement from full-time work in 2012, Dr. Boex returned home to Hudson, Ohio and served as the City's representative on the Summit County Board of Health for approximately six years.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jeffrey L. Anzevino, Mayor of the City of Hudson, Ohio, do hereby recognize Dr. James Boex on his contributions to the healthcare industry and his service to the City of Hudson.
