

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 12-144 TO AUTHORIZE ADDITIONAL CONTINGENCY FUNDS FOR AN EXISTING CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE STATE ROUTE 303 RESURFACING PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 12-144, this Council authorized the City Manager to enter into a contract with the Ohio Department of Transportation (“ODOT”) for the State Route 303 Resurfacing Project; and

WHEREAS, due to unforeseen issues that have arisen during the construction of the Project, additional funds need to be authorized for the contract for this Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Resolution No. 12-144 of this Council is amended to authorize an additional contingency amount not to exceed \$66,273.60 for the contract with ODOT for the State Route 303 Resurfacing Project.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to complete the State Route 303 Resurfacing Project at the earliest possible time in this construction season and for the safety of the users of State Route 303; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
