

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR TWO SNOW PLOW TRUCKS (CABS AND CHASSIS) AND AN AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF SNOW REMOVAL AND SALTING EQUIPMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson is authorized to purchase vehicles through the State of Ohio Procurement State Term Contract and the State Department of Transportation contract; and

WHEREAS, the City has received a price quote for goods that is lower than the pricing in the state contract, and, therefore, it is appropriate for the City to purchase such goods from a vendor with a lower price quote; and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained a price for two new snow plow trucks cabs and chassis from Valley Freightliner Trucks of Cleveland which is lower than the Ohio Department of Transportation (“ODOT”) Purchasing Contract No. 023-13 price; and

WHEREAS, the installation of the snow plow and salting equipment for these trucks can be purchased from and installed by Henderson Truck Equipment-Ohio in an amount that is less than the price in State of Ohio Procurement State Term Schedule Contract No. STS-515.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into and execute on behalf of the City a purchase agreement with Valley Freightliner Trucks of Cleveland, 4985 West 150th Street, Brook Park, OH 44135 for the purchase of two 2014 Freightliner 108SD cabs and chassis in an amount not to exceed \$162,471.00, which is lower than the ODOT contract price and which purchase was approved in the 2013 City Budget.

Section 2: The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into and execute on behalf of the City a purchase agreement with Henderson Truck Equipment-Ohio, 2177 State Route 19, Bucyrus, Ohio 44820, in the amount of \$133,216.00 for the purchase and installation of snow removal and salting equipment on the new cabs and chassis authorized for purchase in Section 1 above, which price is lower than the State Term Schedule Contract No. STS-515 price and which purchase was approved in the 2013 City Budget.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further

reason that it is immediately necessary to make the purchase of and order the subject equipment to keep the City's streets safe for travel by the public during the coming winter season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council elected thereto or six (6) affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from after the earliest period allowed by law.
