

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE ACCEPTANCE BY THE CITY MANAGER’S DESIGNEE OF A 2019 FIRE DEPARTMENT TRAINING GRANT FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE DIVISION OF STATE FIRE MARSHAL.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of State Fire Marshal, provides funding for fire departments; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of State Fire Marshal has awarded the Hudson Fire Department with a 2019 Fire Department Training Grant in the amount of \$1,800.00 for reimbursement towards the cost of training four new volunteers to the level of Volunteer Firefighter; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager’s designee has accepted said grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Council hereby affirms the City Manager’s designee’s acceptance of the 2019 Fire Department Training Grant in the amount of One Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$1,800.00) to be used towards reimbursement of the cost of training as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
