

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER TO THE STATE OF OHIO'S BIENNIAL CAPITAL BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio awards funding for eligible community projects that involve acquiring, building, improving, or equipping facilities that provide a statewide public benefit, such as in higher education, mental health, parks and recreation, conservation, or cultural and sports facilities; and

WHEREAS, these projects are financed through tax-exempt state bonds and must comply with the Ohio Constitution, state law, and federal tax law for the full life of the bond; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson submitted three projects for the year of 2026, specifically:

1. The final phase of the Barlow Farm Park Trail;
2. A stormwater retention pond at Ellsworth Meadows Golf Course; and
3. The development of a Battery Energy Storage System near Hudson Public Power's East Substation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council supports the efforts of the City Manager and City staff in affirming the applications submitted by the City of Hudson.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. That the City Manager and/or his designee are hereby authorized to prepare and execute on behalf of the City any applications and all related paperwork for the Ohio General Assembly's 2026 biennial capital budget. Any actions taken in this regard to date are hereby ratified and affirmed.

Section 2. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
