

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CATTS CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE 2016 CONCRETE REPLACEMENT PROGRAM; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to public advertisement, the bid of Catts Construction, Inc. for the 2016 Concrete Replacement Program has been determined to be the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The bid for the 2016 Concrete Replacement Program by Catts Construction, Inc. being the lowest and best bid, is hereby awarded and the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Catts Construction, Inc. therefor in an amount not to exceed \$471,065.56 which includes a 10% contingency.

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that concrete repairs to the City’s public ways must be made at the earliest possible time for the continued safety of the public and to complete concrete replacement work throughout the City during this construction season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
