

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT FOR THE VALLEY VIEW TRAIL PROJECT (SR 91 TO HUNTING HOLLOW).

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson and Summit County wish to memorialize the responsibilities for the construction and future inspection and maintenance of the City-proposed 10' multi-purpose trail and associated concrete barrier along Valley View Road & Hunting Hollow utilizing the Summit County bridge over Brandywine Creek (No. HUT-025-1083, a county owned and maintained structure) within the City of Hudson from the Northern Corporation line to State Route 303 crossing over Brandywine Creek at Bridge; and

WHEREAS, this agreement applies only for the portion of the trail that goes over the Summit County owned bridge described above; and

WHEREAS, the County shall permit the City of Hudson to construct a new Multi-Purpose Trail across and on top of the existing culvert-type bridge, the City will be responsible for maintenance of all trail related elements and that the County will continue to be responsible for all bridge related elements, including annual inspections and necessary maintenance, except the City will be responsible for any repair to the bridge caused by an errant vehicle striking the vertical concrete barrier wall that will be constructed as part of this project; and

WHEREAS, the Project is targeted to be awarded for construction in 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with the County of Summit for cooperation for the project with Summit County for the Valley View Trail Project (SR91 to Hunting Hollow) and setting forth ongoing maintenance responsibilities.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
