

SPECIAL THANKS TO DR. J. DANIEL WILLIAMS FOR HIS SERVICE TO THE HUDSON COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, in December 1998, Hudson City Council appointed Dr. Williams to serve on the City's Park Board; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Williams resigned from the Park Board after he was elected by Hudson voters in the 2001 Municipal Election to serve as an At-Large Council Member; and he served a four-year term thereafter, which ended in December 2005; and

WHEREAS, City Council appointed Dr. Williams to a partial term on January 5, 2011, to fill a vacancy for At-Large Council Member; and Hudson voters elected Dr. Williams in the 2011 Municipal Election to serve the remainder of the term; and

WHEREAS, Hudson voters re-elected Dr. Williams as an At-Large Council Member in the 2013 and 2017 Municipal Elections to serve two successive four-year terms; and

WHEREAS, at various times during his tenure on Hudson City Council, Dr. Williams served as Council Liaison to the Cemetery Board, Community Television Advisory Committee, and Park Board; and as Council Representative to the Hudson Officials for Mutual Endeavors (HOME) Committee, Income Tax Board of Review, Safe Routes Hudson Committee, and the Volunteer Fire Fighters' Dependents Fund Board; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Williams resigned his At-Large Council position, effective March 20, 2020; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to honor and thank Dr. Williams for his willingness to share his time and knowledge for the good of the community and the residents of Hudson.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, William D. Wooldredge, President of Council of the City of Hudson, Ohio, do hereby urge all residents of the City to acknowledge, congratulate, and thank Councilman J. Daniel Williams for thirteen and one-half years of unselfish, dedicated and accomplished Council service to the Hudson community.
