A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR COMPETITIVE BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE 2023 STORM SEWER LINING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER.

WHEREAS, the lining of City maintained storm sewers and culverts are in need of servicing and maintenance; and,

WHEREAS, lining of the City's storm sewers addresses a safety concern due to the numerous sink holes and require continuous on-going maintenance requirements; and,

WHEREAS, the lining process will eliminate future sink holes caused by separated joints and will extend the life of the storm system pipes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio that:

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to advertise both for a period of at least once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality and for a period of three (3) consecutive weeks on the Municipal website, requesting the submission of bids for the award and enter into a contract for the 2023 Storm Sewer Lining Improvements Project in accordance with the specifications as supplied by the City Engineer's Office.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to sign all necessary documents and enter a contract or contracts on behalf of the City for the 2023 Storm Sewer Lining Improvements Project in an amount to be appropriated by Council, subject to the affixing to the contract by the Finance Director of a certificate of availability of funds therefor, with the lowest and best bidder after receipt of such bids to the extent that such bid is not ten percent (10%) in excess of the Engineer's estimate.
- Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to add a ten percent (10%) contingency amount to the contract with the lowest and best bidder.
- <u>Section 4.</u> The City Manager is further authorized to return all certified checks and bid bonds submitted by the unsuccessful bidders and to reject all bids for said contract or contracts if deemed necessary to do so.
- <u>Section 5.</u> That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.
- Section 6. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
