## 660.22 OBSTRUCTING <u>DITCHES, DRAINS, STORM</u> SEWERS <u>AND OR</u> WATERCOURSES.

- (a) Without a permit issued by the Municipality, no person shall:
- (a) No person shall obstruct (1) Obstruct any ditch, drain, storm sewer or watercourse, along, upon or across any adjacent real property of another or any public street or highway or divert, or easement; or
- (2) <u>Divert</u> any water or drainage from adjacent lands to or upon any <u>adjacent real</u> <u>property of another or to or upon any public street or highway or, without such legal authority or permission as may be required by law, or easement; or</u>
- make (3) Make any connection to any storm sewer or sanitary sewer in or upon any such public street or, highway, or easement.
  - (b) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor of the third degree.
