

RESOLUTION NO. 15-53

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OHIO & ERIE CANALWAY COALITION FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR DESIGN AND ENGINEERING OF PHASE II OF THE VETERANS TRAIL PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Summit County Council has authorized a grant from its Capital Improvement Fund to an organization known as the Ohio & Erie Canalway Coalition for seed money for the Summit County Trail & Greenway Community grant projects that are eligible because of their reference in the Summit County Trail & Greenway Plan; and Veterans Trail in the City of Hudson is part of the Summit County Trail & Greenway Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Park Board has made a recommendation to this Council for submission of a grant application to the Ohio & Erie Canalway Coalition in the amount of \$7,500.00 for design and engineering of Phase II of the Veterans Trail Project; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio & Erie Canalway Coalition requires a resolution of a municipal council to authorize submission of a grant application for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized and directed to apply for the grant set forth in the preamble to this Resolution for the amount of \$7,500.00.

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare of the City, and for the further reason that the grant application is due to be submitted by May 15, 2015; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council elected thereto, or six (6) affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
