A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE 2022 STORM SEWER LINING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to line various storm sewer pipes throughout the City with a cured-in-place liner to eliminate sink holes caused by separated joints and these improvements will improve and extend the life of the sewers within various areas in the City of Hudson.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to advertise both for a period of at least once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality and publication on the Municipal website for three (3) consecutive weeks requesting the submission of construction bids for the purpose of seeking the lowest and best bidder for the 2022 Storm Sewer Lining Improvements Project in accordance with the specifications supplied by the City Engineer's office.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract (or contracts) on behalf of the City in an amount to be appropriated by Council, subject to the affixing to the contract by the Finance Director of a certificate of availability of funds therefor, with the lowest and best bidder after receipt of such bids to the extent that such bid is not ten percent (10%) in excess of the Engineer's estimate and in a form satisfactory to the City Solicitor.
- Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to add a ten percent (10%) contingency amount to the contract with lowest and best bidder.
- Section 4. The City Manager is further authorized to return all certified checks and bid bonds submitted by the unsuccessful bidders and to reject all bids for said contract if deemed necessary to do so.
- Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
  - Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest

period allowed by law.
