

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A POLICE SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE HUDSON SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR POLICE PRESENCE IN ITS SCHOOLS FOR THE SAFETY OF STAFF, STUDENTS AND VISITORS.

WHEREAS, the Hudson School District desires to contract with the City of Hudson for a police presence in its schools for the safety of staff, students, and visitors and institute a School Resource Officer Program; and,

WHEREAS, the School Resource Officer Program is designed to fulfill the overall roles of law enforcement, crime prevention and education; and,

WHEREAS, the City and the School District both desire to enter into a Police Services Agreement for the safety and well-being of the schools and the Hudson community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio as follows:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a Police Services Agreement with the Hudson City Schools for a police presence at Hudson City Schools. The agreement shall be in a form satisfactory to the City Solicitor.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
