

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE SUMMIT COUNTY PUBLIC DEFENDER'S COMMISSION FOR DEFENSE OF INDIGENT DEFENDANTS IN THE STOW MUNICIPAL COURT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 120 of the Ohio Revised Code and Administrative Code 120-1-09, it is necessary for the City of Hudson to enter into an agreement with the Summit County Public Defender's Commission in order for said County to obtain reimbursement for services rendered in providing legal counsel to indigent persons charged with loss of liberty offenses in the City's municipal jurisdiction for all cases opened between January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the Summit County Public Defender's Commission for defense of the indigent persons in the Stow Municipal Court for all cases opened between January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022, a copy of which agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
