A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO STATE FARM TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR TRAINING EQUIPMENT FOR THE HUDSON FIRE DEPARTMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, State Farm provides grant funding for community safety education programs; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires that the City Manager apply for a grant to fund an electronic fire extinguisher training tool, valued at \$15,328.15, on behalf of the City Fire Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized to execute and file an application with State Farm and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

<u>Section 2</u>. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to submit the application for the grant by the October 30, 2015 deadline; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
