A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPOINT AN ADA COORDINATOR AND ADOPT AN ADA POLICY.

WHEREAS, Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requires that public entities ensure equal access to programs, activities and services offered by the public entity; and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with Title II public entities are required to complete several steps to become compliant with the ADA; and

WHEREAS, the initial actions that will set the City on course to comply with the ADA include the appointment of an ADA Coordinator and adopt and post a policy, including a formal grievance procedure; and

WHEREAS, the ADA Coordinator, who may be appointed from existing staff will be responsible for coordination of the remaining requirements of the ADA and ensure ongoing compliance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized to appoint an ADA Coordinator and adopt and post an ADA Policy that includes a Grievance Procedure.

Section 2. That the above recitals are fully incorporated as findings herein.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 4</u>. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
