

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AND INSPECTION SERVICES WITH QUALITY CONTROL INSPECTIONS, INC.; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to a request for proposals, this Council wishes to authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with Quality Control Inspections, Inc. based on its proposal being the most appropriate proposal for professional construction management and/or inspection services for various City capital improvement projects and inspections of private developments from March 1, 2018 to March 1, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with Quality Control Inspections, Inc. (QCI) for professional construction management and/or inspection services for City capital improvement projects and inspections of private developments in accordance with the proposal submitted by QCI and in the amounts appropriated by Council for a term from March 1, 2018 through March 1, 2020.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Hudson for the reason that the City must have its construction management and inspection professionals contracted with prior to the beginning of the 2018 construction season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
