

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE MARCO DIAMOND CLAY SOIL AMENDING CONDITIONER FROM WALKER SUPPLY CO. FOR THE INSTALLATION OF INFIELD MATERIAL AT THE BARLOW FARM PARK BASEBALL COMPLEX; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the athletic baseball fields located at the City's Barlow Farm Park require the installation of new infield soil mix to complete safety and playability improvements; and

WHEREAS, City Park Staff advises that the marco diamond clay soil amending conditioner soil mix meets the required specifications for the required material and is the sole product available to meet the unique and specific needs of the athletic baseball fields; and

WHEREAS, the sole source vendor for diamond clay soil amending conditioner soil mix is the Walker Supply Co. in Coraopolis, PA which distributes the product to the northeast Ohio region.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with the Walker Supply Co. located in Coraopolis, PA for the purchase of diamond clay soil amending conditioner for application to athletic baseball fields at the City's Barlow Farm Park in an amount not to exceed Forty Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$40,950.00).

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to make the purchases of the infield soil amendment material to keep the City's Barlow Farm Park baseball fields safe and playable; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council, except that six (6) affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
