A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SIGNAL SERVICE COMPANY FOR FLASHING SCHOOL ZONE SPEED LIMIT SIGNS AT THE WESTERN RESERVE ACADEMY SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 21-57, passed on May 18, 2021, this Council authorized the City Manager to advertise and enter into a contract for the Flashing School Zone Speed Limit Signs at the Western Reserve Academy Campus ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Project was advertised, and bids were opened on November 16, 2021, and the low bid exceeded the authorized contract amount of \$80,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined to enter into a contract with Signal Service Company for the Project in the amount of \$89,320.00, which includes a 10% contingency amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Hudson, subject to the affixing to the contract by the Director of Finance of his certificate of availability of funds therefor, with Signal Service Company, in an amount not to exceed Eighty-Nine Thousand Three Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$89,320.00), which amount includes a Ten Percent (10%) contract contingency amount.

<u>Section 2:</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3:</u> This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
