

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALKS FOR THE 2012 SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL (“SRTS”) PROGRAM (PID93606); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to advertise for bids for the installation of sidewalks and other amenities for the 2012 Safe Routes to School Program (PID# 93606).

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to authorize the agreement which is the subject of this Resolution in order to meet construction schedule deadlines during the construction season and to install this public infrastructure to improve the safety of citizens; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council elected thereto or six (6) affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from after the earliest period allowed by law.
